Advocacy: Family Caregiver Respite Support

id you know that even with bi-partisan support of a bill it can **STALL** once it reaches Appropriations? In California, bills that request over \$250,000 are automatically placed on **Suspense**, which can be permanent or temporary. The bill will remain permanently in suspension if there is not enough support to push the bill forward. It can be moved if people take action and help push the bill to a hearing.

To **PUSH** a bill out of appropriations, fuel is required. The fuel needed for a bill to move forward is stories, phone calls and/or pictures that can be shared with elected officials in the state capitol.
