

- 1. Log in to www.ralphs.com/signin
- 2. Click on "No Account? Register" at the top.

- You will be instructed to go to your email inbox to confirm your account.

 After you confirm your online account by clicking on the link in your email, return to www.ralphs.com and click on 'Sign In', enter your email address and password.



- View all your information under "My Account" and make sure to add your Ralphs Rewards Card.
- Link your card to the USC FCSC by clicking on the "Community Rewards - Enroll" button.
- 8. Type our NPO number (80612) and click on "Search."
